## MDHHS Updates

### Upcoming Trainings

Michelle went through the upcoming planned FY25 trainings with the committee.

- MI Foundational Cohorts.
- Deliberate Practices in Motivational Interviewing (MI) Cohort – Growing from conceptual knowledge to procedural competency in 13 two-hour virtual webinar sessions.
  - Breaks down the different components of MI. June 17, and September 18, 2025. There are two cohorts being offered so far and the department may add more.
- Dual Disorder IDDT – 3-hour Workshops: Family engagement; Non-Responders; Stage-wise Interventions; Group Services, and more.
- Cognitive Processing Therapy (CPT) for COD (In-person): will be held July 7 - 8, and September 25 - 26, 2025, at the Crowne Plaza Lansing West.
- Cognitive Behavioral Therapy (CBT) training pilot will be held August 18 - 19, 2025. It will be a refresher for immediate/advanced plus it will be CBT with a Co-occurring part of it. The department is looking at CBT and other evidence-based practices (EBPs) (i.e., Dialectical Behavior Therapy (DBT), Assertive Community Treatment (ACT), and CPT). The brochure should be out in the middle of June.
- The 26th Annual Substance Use and Co-Occurring Disorder Hybrid Conference will be held September 7 – 9, 2025, Grand Traverse Resort, Acme, MI.
