

3) outburst - full range verbal, violent profanity, cries, yelling, screaming - all consuming

scary  
hopeless  
sad

this attacks her - don't have control  
seems involuntary 'not herself'

heartbreaking  
painful

attacking body (belief/feels)

voices - very bothersome  
embarrassing

→ happens everywhere, any time, unpredictable, car  
text book description of 'possession'  
unknown if she remembers outbursts  
something sets her off, happens fast, over fast

→ around anyone, anytime

Interventions

try not to get in a car accident / physical injury / fall  
provide emotional comfort + support;  
if med changes or dr appt needed?

need more info in all areas to improve interventions

interactions - observe more

- She likes to have staff around her during outbursts
- need transport to accomplish ADLs  
observe her - dump  
shopping  
paperwork
- attentive and good sense of time - reinforce
- be sure everyone acts same
- disclosure of her voices in small bits
- family may be helpful - but also troubled
- family hx severe abuse
- ask how she can be more comfortable in car
- social conversations help
- new people are scary
- focus on trust + trust building - 'how can I help?'
- let her set order and agenda
- has dr. license, (had car) trailer, father controls
- wondering about through medical evaluation
- lot of pain (back)
