## <u>MIP - Development of an Adult Autism Spectrum Disorder Online Provider Toolkit – Dr.</u> <u>Yavuz Ince</u>

Dr. Yavuz presented on the development of an adult autism spectrum disorder (ASD) free, online provider toolkit for clinicians serving adults. He highlighted the significant challenges faced by individuals with ASD, particularly in social communication and sensory sensitivities, and noted the lack of services available to them during their transition into adulthood.

- The toolkit, which includes videos and handouts, covers a range of topics from diagnosis to associated conditions, with the first section focusing on diagnosis.
- Dr. Yavuz also shared a project aimed at assisting families with educational planning for children with attention deficit hyperactivity disorder (ADHD) and ASD.

<u>Michigan Mental Health Integration Partnership (MIP) – Addressing Unmet Needs for</u> <u>Medicaid Consumers Through Community Colleges - Amy Rusch & Alex Ammann</u> Alex and Amy presented on the mental health improvement through community colleges project.

- Alex and the team will continue working on the Michigan Mental Health Community College landing page at mentalhealthcc.org and the MiNav tool on the dashboard to provide information and resources for community college students.
- Community colleges in Michigan provide some form of personal counseling, but only 42% have dedicated mental health providers, and less than half of these providers focus solely on mental health.
- The team identified the challenges and opportunities in expanding mental health care, with a focus on student needs and the role of administration support.
- The team emphasized the importance of training, partnerships with faculty, and peer support as models for expanding mental health support.

## Overview of the Habilitation Supports Waiver (HSW) Renewal Changes and 1915(i) State Plan Amendment (SPA) - Lyndia Deromedi

Lyndia then presented changes to the Habilitation Supports Waiver (HSW) Waiver renewal and State Plan Amendment (SPA), explaining the shifts in approach based on received feedback.

- The changes included the expansion of eligibility, modifications to service offerings, and updates to provider qualifications for housing assistance.
- The team also discussed the ongoing public comment process for proposed changes and the importance of using specific subject lines when submitting comments.
