Upcoming Trainings

Michelle went through the upcoming FY25 planned trainings with the committee.

- Trauma Informed Care Summit (2-day) will be on December 5 - 6, 2024, at the Hilton in Grand Rapids.
 - Mental health and Substance Use Disorder (SUD) funds will be used for the summit.
 - It will be open to 250 practitioners on the mental health and SUD side.
- The pilot for the free Back to the Basic COD series is continuing for up to three trainings.
 - The series is 2-hours and cover different topics.
- A series of Back to the Basics for COD Assessments will be offered twice.
 - The department is looking at adding an advanced training utilizing Motivational Interviewing.
- Basic Cognitive Behavioral Therapy (CBT) will be held two times and advanced CBT is being worked on.
- Mindfulness Cognitive Processing Therapy will be held three times and are planned for November, February, and May or June.
